### Melbourne United Victorian Junior Basketball League (MUVJBL)

All of Bendigo Bank Junior Braves "First" sides apart from the Under 12's compete in the VJBL in Melbourne and throughout Victoria.

Junior Braves teams train once a week, with VJBL teams training twice a week. BBA pays for the 2nd training venue if this is not at Bendigo Stadium. If a VJBL team wish to train on a 3rd night, it is the responsibility of the team to book and pay for this training venue.

Where possible, teams train at Bendigo Stadium on Sunday's, however at times outside venues are utilised. Where Bendigo Stadium is unavailable on a Sunday, Sports Office staff are responsible for making these bookings, and BBA pays for this.

If a team wishes to train outside of these training days, it is the responsibility of the team to book, advise the JBC administrator and pay for the venue hire.
